## Redefining Growth: Integrating ESG into Your Business

This seminar is to launch a joint KPMG/CLP/HKICS ESG report. In August 2019, 181 CEOs came together and stated that business needs to address stakeholders' concerns. Also, HKEX is requiring a mandatory disclosure requirement (MDR) of board consideration of ESG issues.
